Home Instructions for Cataract Surgery

ACTIVITY:

Rest today, no bending or exertional activity.

Activity requiring coordination or balance, such as driving a car or riding a bicycle, should not be undertaken until all effects of the anesthetic are worn off. This takes 48 hours or more. Do not drive if you are taking any narcotics. Wear shield at bedtime for 1 week. Do not rub your eye. If you have increased redness, decreased vision, or increased pain call doctor immediately.

DIET:

Start slowly and see how your stomach tolerates food then advance to a regular diet.

MEDICATION INSTRUCTIONS:

When you get home from surgery, instill one drop of each medication in the operative eye 4 more times the day of surgery, once you get home. During your postop visit with Dr. Vlasov, you will receive instructions on how to continue your drops during your postop period. Shake eye drops well before use. Wait 5 minutes between all drops.

Do not use <u>Tetracaine</u> drops after surgery.

Keep your follow up appointment for the date and time given to you.
