Vaginal Spotting:

After your surgery, you might have some light vaginal bleeding. Please use a pad or panti-liner. Do not use tampons. If you have bright red or heavy vaginal bleeding, please contact your doctor.

Personal Hygiene:

Please do not put anything into your vagina for two weeks. This includes tampons and douching.

Showers:

Showers are preferred. Please no tub baths for two weeks.

Intimate Relations:

Please do not have intercourse for two weeks or until your doctor advises you that it is safe for you to resume sexual activities.

Housework:

No heavy housework or heavy lifting for several days after your surgery. Let your family and friends help you during this time!

Menstrual Cycle:

Your surgery may interrupt your normal menstrual cycle.

Follow-up Appointment:

It is very important for you to keep the appointment that has been made for you. If you need to reschedule, please call your doctor's office and we will be happy to find a more convenient time.

Please call your doctor for any of the following:

Temperature of 100 degrees or higher
Severe pain
Heavy bleeding
Bad odor from your vagina
